

NEED TO KNOW

What you need to bring:

- Bible
- Notebook
- Pen
- Bed linens (twin-sized mattress only provided)
- Pillow
- blanket/sleeping bag
- bath towels
- toiletries (soap, shampoo, etc.)

Please do NOT bring:

- cell phones,
- entertainment items such as mp3 players, laptops, tablets, DVDs, headphones, ear buds, etc;
- Tobacco, vaping devices,
- knives,
- tasers,
- lighters, matches, fireworks, etc.

Dress Code:

All dress expectations apply to campers, counselors, and parents attending camp. In order to maintain the intended atmosphere at all times, we ask that no one wear clothing that depicts anything that could be considered un-Christian or anything in poor taste. The Camp Director or Staff reserve the right to ask a camper to change their clothing if it is considered inappropriate. Thank you!

- Girl's Clothing:
 - Girls should wear modest dresses and skirts.
 - Sundresses, low necklines, or split skirts above the knees are not allowed.
 - Knee-length culottes can be worn for activities. Long Shorts are not culottes. and are not permitted.
 - Pants are not permitted.
- Boy's Clothing:
 - Boys must wear long pants.
 - Athletic and sweat pants may be worn for activities.
 - Net, half, or sleeveless shirts are not allowed.
- Swimming:
 - Boys and girls swim at separate times, but must be clothed at all times with dark-colored shirts and knee-length shorts while swimming and while walking back and forth to the lake.

A swim test must be passed to allow campers to swim in deep water or to our floating dock. Rough-housing, dunking, and unsafe behavior will not be tolerated.
